to purchase yourself!

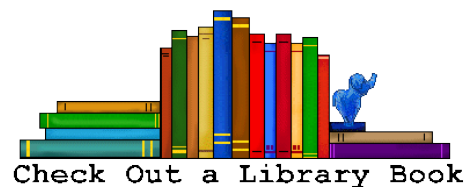
If you have anything you are still working on, there is still plenty of time to finish.

July 13, 2017

**Program:** Debbie Johnson-President Clemmons Guild – Trunk show and lecture.

Debbie was president for 9 years of the Clemmons Guild. Then decided she wanted to try different techniques and starting doing more Art Quilts. She showed some very beautiful quilts and gave a very interesting talk about how she came to excel in this technique.

She still handles an open retreat for the Guild. It's the week before Thanksgiving at Camp Walter Johnson in Denton NC which is run by the Salvation Army.

Susan has accepted a challenge with the Kernersville Guild. They said that their charity quilts are more beautiful than ours and they could contribute more quilts. So let's show them that they are wrong.

Help is needed for show days, sign-up sheets are at the front table.

Friday is set up day, vendors will be able to set up after 5:00 pm

One vendor will be there early Saturday to set up.

Surveillance for the quilts will be provided.

Box luncheons will be provided for vendors. There will be a Ham and Swiss on Potato Roll and a Turkey/Cheddar on a Potato Roll. Chips and water will be provided.
